Dear families,

We continue to have a COVID-19 outbreak in our facility. We have had quite a few cases since the holiday.

Please do not visit if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 which can be as mild as allergy or cold symptoms. Please do not visit if you have been exposed to COVID-19 and are considered a close contact. You must be recovered for 10 days if you have had COVID before you can visit the community.
