Dear families,

We have a large amount of unmarked and unclaimed clothing. It has been gathered and placed in the Parlor sitting room. If your loved one is missing anything, please come and go through the clothing to see if you can locate it. We will leave it there until Monday 8/15/2022. Anything still there on Monday will be taken to Goodwill and donated. Please remember to clearly mark items when you bring them and add them to the inventory sheet.

We continue to have staff that are testing positive for COVID-19. Any residents that have been identified as a close contact have been tested and are in Transmission Based Precautions. Vaccinated residents identified as a close contact are being monitored for symptoms. If symptoms arise for anyone, we test them immediately. At this time, we do not have any positive residents identified.

We will continue to test all unvaccinated staff who are not up to date with boosters twice a week until two weeks pass with no positive results. If a resident on Assisted Living shows any symptoms, they are tested at that time also. We continue with cleaning high touch surfaces often on top of our normal housekeeping regimen.

We will not stop visitation, but we do ask that it be kept at a minimum for the safety of our residents and for you. When visiting, PPE is a must at all times in the building. If your loved one has a roommate, the visit needs to occur in one of the dining rooms or lounges so the roommate is not possibly exposed. Please do not visit in their rooms if a roommate is present at this time.

Please continue to screen in and do not visit if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 which can be as mild as allergy symptoms. Please do not visit if you have been exposed to COVID-19.

Please know we are doing our best to mitigate this terrible virus. If your loved one has not been vaccinated or has not had the booster, please reconsider this choice and reach out to me so I can get the vaccine or booster process started for them.
